









-  **NECESSITY.** There are 4 pieces to a "complete" duplication package - duplicator, on-disc-printer, insert printer, and WRAPPER. Wrapping has two choices - *shrinkwrap & overwrap*
-  **QUALITY.** Overwrap is the preferred standard for retail CD, cassette & DVD packaging.
-  **EFFICIENCY.** Precut sheets means no waste. That's good for the budget and the environment. No fumes either. A shrinkwrapper cuts the film by burning it, creating unpleasant odors. An overwrapper adheres the film to itself using heat, but does not burn.
-  **APPEARANCE.** Overwrapping produces packages wrapped uniformly, whereas shrinkwrapping produces rough edges with unsightly seams.
-  **SPEED.** Capable of up to 6 wraps per minute.
-  **LOW MAINTENANCE.** No wires or teflon strips to replace as required by a shrinkwrapper. The CD3 has no consumable components.
-  **LOW COST.** The CD3 is priced much lower than similar semi-automated overwrappers. The CD3 also has a low operating cost - as little as 2¢ per sheet.
-  **SIZE.** Fits comfortably on less than half the space of an average desktop. Ideal for small shops with limited work space.
